ORDINANCE NO. 74-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 73-13 OF SAID TOWNSHIP WHICH PROVIDED FOR A FIRE PREVENTION CODE REGULATING PROPERTY AND STRUCTURES AND THEIR USES FOR THE PROTECTION OF LIFE AND PROPERTY AGAINST THE HAZARDS OF FIRE AND EXPLOSION; ESTABLISHING A BUREAU OF FIRE PREVENTION FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF SAID CODE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, a municipal corporation situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. That Section 19 (a) of Ordinance No. 73-13 which reads as follows:

- (a) "Any person who shall violate Section 7 of this Ordinance by parking or leaving an unattended motor vehicle standing in a properly marked fire lane shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of Two Dollars (\$2.00) and costs of prosecution," is amended to read as follows:
- (a) "Any person who shall violate Section 7 of this Ordinance by parking or leaving an unattended motor vehicle standing in a properly marked fire lane shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and costs, provided that if paid within seventy-two (72) hours after violation the fine shall be Three Dollars (\$3.00), and costs."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective JULY 3, 1974.

ORDINANCE NO. 74-4
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 73-13 OF SAID TOWNSHIP WHICH PROVIDED FOR A FIRE PREVENTION CODE REGULATING PROPERTY AND STRUCTURES AND THEIR USES FOR THE PROTECTION OF LIFE AND PROPERTY AGAINST THE HAZARDS OF FIRE AND EXPLOSION; ESTABLISHING A BUREAU OF FIRE PREVENTION FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF SAID CODE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, a municipal corporation situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. That Section 19 (a) of Ordinance No. 73-13 which reads as follows:

(a) "Any person who shall violate Section 7 of this Ordinance by parking or leaving an unattended motor vehicle standing in a properly marked fire lane shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of Two Dollars (\$2.00) and costs of prosecution," is amended to read as follows:

(a) "Any person who shall violate Section 7 of this Ordinance by parking or leaving an unattended motor vehicle standing in a properly marked fire lane shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and costs, provided that if paid within seventy-two (72) hours after violation the fine shall be Three Dollars (\$3.00), and costs."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective July 3, 1974.
