## ORDINANCE NO. 74-5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE 1961 ZONING ORDINANCE OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, in conformity with the provisions of the Pennsylvania

Municipalities Planning Code a public hearing was held on July 2, 1974,

to consider the adoption of the within amendment to the Official Zoning

Map of the 1961 Zoning Ordinance of Hopewell Township; and

WHEREAS, public notice of said hearing was given, as required by Section 609 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code; and

WHEREAS, the within amendment has been submitted to the Hopewell Township Planning Commission and the Beaver County Planning Commission for advisory recommendation, as required by Section 609 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has reviewed the written recommendations of the aforesaid planning agencies and the expressions made at the public hearing of July 2, 1974.

NOW, therefore, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under THE FIRST CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE set in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

1. That the Official Zoning Map referred to and made part of Township Ordinance No. 61-10, the 1961 Zoning Ordinance of Hopewell Township, is hereby amended to rezone the following premises from C-2 Roadside Commercial to R-3 General Residential:

"ALL that certain parcel of land situate in Hopewell Township,
Beaver County, Pennsylvania, being a contiguous tract, beginning at a
point on the easterly right-of-way line of Mill Street at its intersection
with Maple Avenue; thence in a northerly direction along the easterly rightof-way line of Mill Street to Raccoon Street; thence easterly along the

southerly right-of-way line of Raccoon Street to Linden Avenue; thence in a southerly direction along the westerly right-of-way line of Linden Avenue to Maple Avenue; thence in a southerly direction along the northerly right-ofway of Maple Avenue to Mill Street, the place of beginning.

- 2. That the Board of Commissioners specifically finds the rezoning of the above described premises to be in accordance with the community development objectives contained in the Hopewell Township Comprehensive Plan.
- 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable and if any of the provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the ordinance.
- 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
