ORDINANCE NO. 74-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER  
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A RECREATION  
BOARD

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, a municipal corporation under The First Class Township Code situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

1. THAT pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 3009 and 3010 of The First Class Township Code (53 P.S. Sections 58009, 58010), as amended, a Recreation Board is hereby established to equip, supervise and maintain parks, recreation areas and facilities and to conduct recreation programs in the Township of Hopewell.

2. THAT the Recreation Board hereby established shall possess all the powers and be subject to all the responsibilities imposed upon such boards by (a) the Act of June 24, 1931, P.L. 1206, Article XXX (53 P.S. Section 58009 et seq.), as amended, and (b) any Ordinance of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell not conflicting with the provisions of the aforesaid Act of Assembly.

3. THAT said Recreation Board shall consist of seven persons, two of whom shall be members or appointees of the Hopewell Area School Board and the remaining members of which shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell.

4. THAT the members of said Recreation Board shall serve for terms of five calendar years commencing on the 1 day of JAN., 1975, or until their successors are appointed. Provided, however, that the members of the Recreation Board first appointed hereunder shall be appointed for the following terms:

- (a) Two (2) members to serve for a term of five years.
- (b) One (1) member to serve for a term of four years.

- (c) One (1) member to serve for a term of three years.
- (d) One (1) member to serve for a term of two years.
- (e) Two (2) members to serve for a term of one year.

5. THAT all members of the Recreation Board shall serve without pay and may be removed for cause, including malfeasance or nonfeasance of duty, by the Board of Commissioners.

6. THAT the standards, qualifications and salary schedules for all classifications of personnel to be engaged in the joint recreation program shall be subject to the prior approval of the Board of Commissioners and/or the Board of Directors of the Hopewell Area School District, as respectively provided in Section 3009 of the aforesaid Act of Assembly (53 P.S. Section 58009) and the provisions of the Agreement of JULY 31, 197~~4~~, between the Township of Hopewell and the Hopewell Area School District establishing a cooperative plan for a joint recreation program.

7. THAT it is the declared intention of the Board of Commissioners that the joint recreation program now existing in the Township of Hopewell shall not be interrupted by the transition to be effected in the enactment of this Ordinance or by the imposition upon the Recreation Board of the powers and responsibilities hereinabove set forth. That, accordingly, the Recreation Board herewith established is hereby declared to be the successor of all property, rights and responsibilities of the Recreation Board heretofore created by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell which are not inconsistent with the rights, duties and responsibilities herewith imposed.

8. THAT the Recreation Board heretofore created by the Board of Commissioners is hereby abolished.

9. THAT the provisions of this Ordinance shall be effective on  
JAN 1, 1975; all ordinances and resolutions  
inconsistent herewith and hereby repealed.
