AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION TO BE PAID

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the TOWNSHIP OF
HOPEWELL, a municipal corporation under The First Class Township Code
situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT
IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

1. Beginning on the first day of January, A.D. 197⁵, the compensation

appointed after the adoption of this Ordinance may be the maximum amount
permitted as the General Assembly may, from time to time determine,
except as restricted by the provisions of Section 603 of the First Class
Township Code.
