ORDINANCE NO. 75-3

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING HAWKING, PEDDLING, OR TRAVELING FROM PLACE TO PLACE WITH GOODS, WARES, AND MERCHANDISE OR PRODUCE, AND SELLING OR OFFERING THE SAME FOR SALE, OR SOLICITING ORDERS FOR THE SALE OF THE SAME WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, hereby enact and ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons whomsoever to hawk, peddle goods, wares, or merchandise or solicit orders for the sale of the same in Hopewell Township without first having obtained a license or permit therefore.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of the Manager-Secretary of the Township to issue licenses or permits to hawk, peddle, sell or offer for sale, or solicit orders for the sale of goods, wares, or merchandise within the Township of Hopewell upon the payment of the following fees:

(a) Each solicitor, peddler, or salesman, \$5 per day or fraction thereof; \$20 per week of six days; \$60 per calendar month; and \$200 per year.

SECTION 3. The following persons are exempt from paying the fees as hereinabove provided; however, they must register with the Manager-Secretary and upon registration as aforesaid will be issued a permit:

- (a) Farmers selling produce raised by them;
- (b) Resident grocers and merchantmen;
- (c) Charitable organizations; and
- (d) Persons selling bread and bakery products, meat and meat products, milk and milk products.

SECTION 4. Salesmen selling goods exclusively to merchants only are exempt from the provision of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful to hawk or peddle goods, wares and merchandise, or to solicit orders for the sale of the same within Hopewell Township after 9:00 P.M., prevailing time.

SECTION 6. It shall be unlawful for any person to solicit from door to door, within Hopewell Township, after 5:00 P.M, prevailing time.

SECTION 7. Any person or persons committing any of the unlawful acts above enumerated shall be subject on conviction before a Justice of the Peace of the Township of Hopewell, to a fine or not more than \$100, together with costs of prosecution and in default of payment of the fine and costs shall be imprisoned in the Beaver County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

SECTION 8. In case any section or part of a section of this Ordinance shall be declared illegal or unconstitutional, the remaining section, and parts thereof, shall be valid and not be affected thereby.

SECTION 9. All other ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as the same conflict herewith.
