## ORDINANCE NO. 75-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 60-2 WHICH PROVIDES FOR SEWER DISPOSAL, SETTING FORTH SPECIFICATIONS, TABLES, TESTS, RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF SEPTIC TANKS AND SEPTIC TANKS SYSTEM, PROVIDING FOR FEES AND IMPOSING PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 60-2 which reads as follows:

"Where such waste, sewage, feces, used water or other similar foul matter if directed or caused to flow into a septic tank, a permit shall be procured at the time of the installation of the same and a fee in the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars shall be paid to the Township Secretary at the time of making the application for the construction of the same."

"Where such waste, sewage, feces, used water or other similar foul matter is directed or caused to flow into a septic tank, a permit shall be procured at the time of the installation of the same and a fee in the sum of Seventy-five (\$75.00) Dollars shall be paid to the Township Secretary at the time of making the application for the construction of the same.

ORDINANCE NO. 75-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 60-2 WHICH PROVIDES FOR SEWER DIS-POSAL, SETTING FORTH SPECIFICA-TIONS, TABLES, TESTS, RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUC-TION AND MAINTENANCE OF SEPTIC TANKS AND SEPTIC TANKS SYSTEM, PROVIDING FOR FEES AND IMPOSING PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 60-2 which reads as fol-

"Where such waste, sewage, feces, used water or other similar foul matter if directed or caused to flow into a septic tank, a permit shall be procured at the time of the installation of the same and a fee in the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars shall be paid to the Township Secretary at the time of making the application for the construction of the same." is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Where such waste, sewage, feces, used water or other similar foul matter is directed or caused to flow into a septic tank, a permit shall be procured at the time of the installation of the same and a Dollars shall be paid to the Township plication for the construction of the same.
