ORDINANCE NO. 75-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FORMALLY ACCEPTING AS PUBLIC STREETS THE SEVERAL ENUMERATED STREETS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP WHICH HAVE BEEN FULLY MAINTAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS BUT NEVER FORMALLY ACCEPTED.

WHEREAS, drivers streets have been laid out within Hopewell Township and dedicated to public use for highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, there appears to be no record of formal acceptance of the dedication of said streets; and

WHEREAS, the Township has for a number of years fully maintained said streets and treated the same as accepted public streets.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it Ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under the First Class Township Code situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Ordained:

1. That pursuant to the authority contained in the First Class Township Code all of the streets hereinafter described are hereby accepted as public streets:

(a) Maple Avenue - from Mill Street to Elm Street.

Having a fifty foot right of way and being 0.38 miles in length.

(b) Mercer Street - from Stamm Drive to dead end.

Having a 35 foot right of way and being 0.13 miles in length.

(c) Morningside Drive - From Maratta Road to dead end. Having a 40 foot right of way and being 0.15 miles in length.

(d) Ridgeway Avenue - from Maratta Road to Cabot Drive. Having a 50 foot right of way and being 0.27 miles in length.

2. That the aforesaid streets are declared to be and shall hereafter be regarded as part of the highway system of the Township of Hopewell.

(b) Mercer Street — from Stamm Drive to dead end. Having a 35 foot right of way and being 0.13 miles in length.

(c) Morningside Drive — From Maratta Road to dead end. Having a 40 foot right of way and being 0.15 miles in length.

(d) Ridgeway Avenue — from Maratta Road to Cabot Drive. Having a 50 foot right of way and being 0.27 miles in length.

2. That the aforesaid streets are declared to be and shall hereafter be regarded as part of the highway system of the Township of Hopewell.
