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## ORDINANCE 76-1

## ORDINANCE OF MUNICIPAL AUTHORITIES TO FORM JOINT AUTHORITY

76-1 signifying the joint desire and intention of the municipal authorities of the Borough of Aliquippa and the Township of Hopewell, both municipalities of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and both Situated in Beaver County, to organize an authority under the "Municipality Authorities Act of 1945," designated as Act No. 164, approved May 2, 1945, together with all supplements thereof, and amendments thereto; for the purpose of constructing or otherwise providing the facilities necessary to furnish bus transportation for the Borough of Aliquippa and the Township of Hopewell, and such adjoining political subdivisions and areas as may desire such services. All of the political subdivisions and other areas being situated in Beaver County; and also for the purpose of exercising and enjoying any and all of the powers conferred by said Act, the Supplements thereof, or Amendments thereto; and setting forth in full, the Proposed Articles of Incorporation, and other matters pertaining to the creating of said authority.

Be it enacted by the Council of the Borough of Aliquippa and the Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Authority of the same as follows:

Sec. 1. Joint Authority. It is the joint desire and intention of the municipal authorities of the Borough of Aliquippa and the Township of Hopewell, both municipalities of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and both

situated in Beaver County, to organize an Authority under the "Municipalities Authorities Act of 1945," designated as Act No. 164, approved May 2, 1945, together with all supplements thereof, and amendments thereto, for the purpose of exercising and enjoying all the powers of the Act, its Supplements, or Amendments.

- Sec. 2. Name of Authority. The name of the proposed Authority is: Greater Aliquippa Transit Authority.
- Sec. 3. Articles of Incorporation. The Proposed Articles of Incorporation of the Authority are as follows:

"In compliance with the Municipal Authorities Act of 1945, its supplements and amendment, the borough of Aliquippa and the Township of Hopewell, both situated in Beaver County, and both municipalities of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, pursuant to identical ordinances duly adopted by the representative municipal authorities of all municipalities, signifying their joint desire and intention to form an authority, hereby certify:

- "1. The name of the Authority shall be: Greater Aliquippa Transit Authority".
- 2. This Authority is formed under the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, its supplements and amendments.
- 3. No other joint Authority organized under the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, its supplements or amendments, the Act approved June 28, 1935, P.L. 463, as amended, is in existence in or for the

incorporating municipalities named herein.

- 4. The purpose of the authority is to construct or otherwise provide the facilities necessary to furnish bus transportation.
  - 5. The respective names of the incorporating municipalities are:

The Borough of Aliquippa, and

The Township of Hopewell.

Sec. 4. Appointment of Board. The following persons, respectively hereinafter designated as appointees of either the Borough of Aliquippa,

or the Township of Hopewell, are hereby appointed members of the Board of the Authority, with the following terms of office:

- (b) Charles Ianhini Secretary, whose Term expires on December 31, 1977
- (c) Leonard Werling Treasurer, whose Term expires on December 31, 1979
- (d) George Glomb Whose term expires on December 31, 1980
- (e) Charlie Lay Whose term expires on December 31, 1978

Sec. 5. Salaries. The total annual salary, if any, to be paid the Authority Board Members shall be determined by resolution of the Town Council of the Borough of Aliquippa and the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell.

- Sec. 6. Execution of Articles of Incorporation. The Articles of Incorporation of the Authority, in substantially the form set forth in Section 3 of this ordinance, shall be executed on behalf of the Borough of Aliquippa by the Mayor and President of Council, and under its municipal seal, attested by the Secretary of the Borough, and the Township of Hopewell by the Chairman of the Board and under its municipal seal, attested by the Secretary of the Township, and such officers are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to do all things necessary and appropriate to effect and establish the said Authority, in conformity with the "Municipal Authorities Act of 1945." its supplements and amendments.
- Sec. 7. General Welfare. The adoption of this ordinance is deemed necessary for the benefit and preservation of the public health, peace, comfort, and general welfare, and will increase the prosperity of the people of the Borough of Aliquippa and the Township of Hopewell.

Sec. 8. Effective Date. That this ordinance shall become effective
upon final passage.
