AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, COUNTY OF BEAVER, AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 1977 AND APPROPRIATING SPECIFIC SUMS ESTIMATED TO BE REQUIRED FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSES OF THE TOWNSHIP GOVERNMENT, HEREINAFTER SET FORTH, DURING THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, County of Beaver, Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said township subject to taxation for township purposes for the fiscal year 1977 as follows:

Tax rate for general township purposes, the sum of eight and seven tenths mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of eighty seven cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

For debt purposes, the sum of one and three tenths mills on each dollar assessed valuation, or the sum of thirteen cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

SECTION 2. That the amounts appropriated from the revenue available for the current year for specific purposes are fully itemized in the Budget Form.

SECTION 3. An estimate of the specific items making up the amounts appropriated to the respective Departments is on file in the office of the Manager-Secretary of the Township, Clark Boulevard and Circle Drive, Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 4. All Taxpayers subject to the payment of taxes, assessed by any taxing district, shall be entitled to a discount of at least two per centum from the amount of such tax upon making payment of the whole amount thereof within two months after the date of the tax notice. All taxpayers, who shall fail to make payment of any such taxes charged against them for four months after the date of the tax notice, shall be charged a penalty of five (5) per centum which penalty shall be added to the taxes by the tax collector and be collected by him.

SECTION 5. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
