Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell will consider the adoption of the following ordinance at its regular meeting.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TAKING OVER AND ADOPTING, WESTFIELD DRIVE IN THE WESTFIELD PLAN IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AS A PUBLIC STREET.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. The following street in Westfield Plan, as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County, Pennsylvania in Plan Book 12 page 10 is hereby taken over and adopted as a public street in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Westfield Drive, having a fifty (50) foot right of way and a twenty-four (24) foot cartway at existing grades starting at Gringo-Independence Road (Legislative Route 04125) and terminating at a cul-de-sac, a distance of 674 linear feet.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell will meet on Thursday, July 14, 1977 at 8:00 P.M. at the Municipal Building, Clark Boulevard, Aliquippa, PA, to consider the enactment of said ordinance.
