ORDINANCE NO. 77-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FORMALLY ACCEPTING AS PUBLIC STREETS THE SEVERAL ENUMERATED STREETS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP WHICH HAVE BEEN FULLY MAINTAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS BUT NEVER FORMALLY ACCEPTED.

WHEREAS, drivers streets have been laid out within Hopewell Township and dedicated to public use for highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, there appears to be no record of formal acceptance of the dedication of said streets; and

WHEREAS, the Township has for a number of years fully maintained said streets and treated the same as accepted public streets.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation under the First Class Township Code situate in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Ordained:

(a) Winchester Avenue (Formerly known as Hopewell Avenue), beginning at Brodhead Road and terminating at a dead end, having a forty (40') foot right of way and an eighteen foot cartway and being 0.13 miles in length, as recorded in the Beaver County Court House, Plat Book 4, Page 63.

(b) Boake Drive - beginning at Gringo-Independence Road and terminating at a dead end, having a thirty-three foot right of way and an eighteen foot cartway, being 0.19 miles in length, shown on survey drawing by Daniel C. Baker, dated August 3, 1944.

(c) Overlook Avenue - Beginning at Buchanan Avenue and terminating at Poplar Street, having a forty (40) foot right of way and a twenty (20') foot cartway and being .09 miles in length; as recorded in the Beaver County Court House, Plat Book 4, Page 66.

(d) Pearl Street - (Formerly known as Temple Street), beginning at Temple Road and terminating at a dead end, having a thirty three (33') foot right of way and an eighteen (18') foot cartway and being .11 miles in length; as recorded in the Beaver County Court House, Plat Book 4, Page 95.

(e) High Street - Beginning at Temple Road and terminating at a dead end, having a forty (40') foot right of way

and an eighteen (18') foot cartway and being .10 miles in length; as recorded in the Beaver County Court House, Plat Book 4, Page 95.

(f) Windle Avenue - Beginning at Walnut Street and terminating at a dead end, having a forty (40') foot right of way and twenty one (21') foot cartway and being .06 miles in length; as recorded in the Beaver County Court House, Plat Book 5, Page 123.

(g) Walnut Street - Beginning at Temple Road and terminating at a dead end, having a forty (40') foot right of way an eighteen (18') foot cartway, and being .05 miles in length; as recorded in the Beaver County Court House, Plat Book 5, Page 123.

(h) Huron Street - Beginning at Cedarcrest Avenue and ending 727 L.F. East, having a thirty (30') foot right of way and an eighteen (18') foot cartway, and being .14 miles in length; as recorded in the Beaver County Court House, Plat Book 4, Page 6 and Plat Book 9, Page 56.

(i) Davidson Way - Beginning at Maratta Road and terminating at a dead end, having a thirty (30') foot right of way and an eighteen (18') foot cartway, and being .09 miles in length; as recorded in the Beaver County Court House, Plat Book 5, Page 58.

(j) Western Avenue - Beginning at Davidson Way and terminating at a dead end, having a forty (40') foot right of way and an eighteen foot cartway and being .09 miles in length; as recorded in the Beaver County Court House, Plat Book 5, Page 58.

(k) Anderson Avenue - Beginning at Maratta Road and terminating at Vue Avenue (formerly Ridge Alley,) and having a forty (40') foot right of way and a twenty (20') foot cartway, and being .09 miles in length; as recorded in the Beaver County Court House, Plat Book 3, Page 42.

2. That the aforesaid streets are declared to be and shall hereafter be regarded as part of the highway system of the Township of Hopewell.
