ORDINANCE NO. 78-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 78-5, SECTION 500
PROVIDING FOR AN EXCAVATORS PERMIT, THIS
AMENDMENT PROVIDING FOR AN EXCLUSION TO
THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 500 INsofar
AS SECTION 500 REQUIRES AN EXCAVATORS PERMIT
FOR PERSONS EXCAVATING, INSTALLING, REPAIR-
ING, ALTERING and/or CLEANING SANITARY SEWER
SYSTEMS ON REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY SAID PERSONS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the
Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained
and enacted according to the power and authority granted under the first class
Township Code;

SECTION 500-1


Section 500 of Ordinance No. 78-5 shall not apply to persons
excavating, installing, repairing, altering and/or cleaning sanitary sewer
systems on real property owned by said persons, when said persons owning such
property do not employ, contract with, engage, or otherwise secure the services
of outside help for hire or other consideration, PROVIDED; This exclusion
shall not be applicable to a property owner developing properties for sale,
or otherwise engaging in any land development with the intent of selling,
procuring an option for sale, and/or leasing said land development.

Section 500 of Ordinance No. 78-5
shall not apply to persons excavat-
ing, installing, repairing, altering
and/or cleaning sanitary sewer sys-
tems on real property owned by said
persons, when said persons owning
such property do not employ, con-
tract with, engage, or otherwise se-
cure the services of outside help for
hire or other consideration, PRO-
VIDED, This exclusion shall not be
applicable to a property owner de-
veloping properties for sale, or oth-
erwise engaging in any land devel-
opment with the intent of selling,
procuring an option for sale, and/or
leasing said land development.
