ORDINANCE 78-8

TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL,
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE
CONSTRUCTION AND ESTIMATED COSTS OF A CERTAIN
LINE EXTENSION TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN LONGVUE
AVENUE IN THE SAID TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BY
THE CRESWELL HEIGHTS JOINT AUTHORITY AND
APPROVING THE CHARGING OF THE COSTS OF SUCH
CONSTRUCTION BY SAID AUTHORITY AGAINST THE
PROPERTIES BENEFITED, IMPROVED OR ACCOMMODATED
THEREBY ACCORDING TO THE FOOT-FRONT METHOD.

WHEREAS, plans, specifications and project cost estimates
for the construction of 1,340 lineal feet, more or less, of a 10-inch
water line in Longvue Avenue (the same connecting the existing 6-inch line
in Longvue Avenue with the 10-inch water main laid at the intersection of
Longvue Avenue and Knoll Street), have been submitted by the Creswell
Heights Joint Authority to the Board of Commissioners of the said Township
of Hopewell; and

WHEREAS, said plans, specifications and project cost
estimates have been prepared by the Authority's Consulting Engineers,
Michael Baker, Jr., Inc., and the same have been approved by the Authority;
and

WHEREAS, the total project cost for said line construction
including Engineering Design, General Inspection and Resident Inspection is
estimated not to exceed \$38,988; and

WHEREAS, Section 4B (s) of the Municipality Authorities
Act of 1945, as amended, requires that the Board of Commissioners of the
Township of Hopewell approve said Project and its estimated cost of con-
struction before charges may be assessed and collected against the proper
benefited, improved or accommodated thereby according to the foot-front

NOW, therefore, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board
of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation
The First Class Township Code, being situate in the County of Beaver in
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. That the following described water line extension (hereinafter, the "Project") to be constructed by the Creswell Heights Joint Authority in Longvue Avenue in the Township of Hopewell and the total estimated cost of construction of said Project, as set forth in the plans, specifications and Project cost estimates prepared by Michael Baker, Jr., Inc., Consulting Engineers of the Creswell Heights Joint Authority, the same annexed hereto and by reference made a part hereof, are hereby approved:

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

The construction of 1,340 feet, more or less, of 10-inch water main to be laid in Longvue Avenue, a Township street, to connect the existing 6-inch water line in Longvue Avenue with the 10-inch water main laid at the intersection of Longvue Avenue and Knoll Street in the said Township of Hopewell.

SECTION 2. That copies of the plans, specifications and Project cost estimates of said Project shall be maintained at the Offices of the Township Secretary located in the Municipal Building at Circle Drive and Clark Boulevard in the said Township of Hopewell, and the same shall be available for inspection by the general public during regular business hours.

SECTION 3. That the estimated cost of said Project, the same including estimated construction cost, Engineering Design, General Inspection and Resident Inspection as hereinafter itemized, the sum of \$38,988, is hereby approved for the purpose and with the effect set forth in Section 4B(s) of the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, as amended:

SECTION 4. That the proposal of the Creswell Heights Joint Authority to assess the cost of construction of said Project against the properties within Hopewell Township and fronting Longvue Avenue that are

benefited, improved and accommodated thereby in accordance with the foot-front method is hereby approved.

SECTION 5. That the estimated foot-front rate to be charged against the foot-frontage of such properties so benefited, improved or accommodated by said Project, the sum of \$14.55 per foot-front, is hereby approved.

SECTION 6. That should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by any Court of lawful jurisdiction to be invalid, it is hereby declared to be the intention of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell that the same shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections or provisions hereof.

SECTION 7. That all Ordinances or Resolutions, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they may be conflicting herewith.

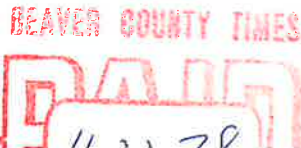
