AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 77-6 AMENDING SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE ITEM 4 STATING ENFORCEMENT OF SAID ORDINANCE SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT.
