ORDINANCE NO. 80-10

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, APPROPRIATING MONIES FROM MUNICIPAL TAXES AND REVENUES TO DEFRAY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 1981 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1981

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, County of Beaver, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted according to the power and authority granted under the first class Township Code, Act of June 24, 1931 P.L. 1206 et al, as finally amended by Act of December 14, 1967, P.L. 819, effective January 1, 1969:

SECTION 1: That the following sums of money, or as much thereof as may be authorized by law, as may be needed or deemed necessary to defray all expenses and liabilities of the Township, be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purposes and objects of said Township hereinafter specified for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of January, 1981, and ending on the 31st day of December, 1981.
