ORDINANCE NO. 80-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 78-2 PROVIDING FOR INCREASE OF SCHOOLS RENTAL RATES FOR USE OF THE SEWER SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF A LEASE AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO WITH HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 78-2 which reads as follows:

"The sewer rental to schools shall be not less than One dollar and ten cents (\$1.10) per pupil per quarter."

be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The sewer rental to schools shall be not less than One dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) per pupil per quarter."

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1980.
