AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 78-3 PROVIDING FOR SEWER RENTALS FOR NON-RESIDENTIAL USERS OF THE TOWNSHIP SEWER SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF A LEASE AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO WITH THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I. That portion of Ordinance No. 78-3, which reads,

"All sewer rentals based upon water consumption shall be computed at the following rates based on metered water use:

First	12,000 gallons	-----	\$25.00 minimum per quarter
NEXT	42,000 gallons	-----	\$ 1.90 per 1000 gallons per quarter
NEXT	90,000 gallons	-----	\$ 1.60 per 1000 gallons per quarter
NEXT	240,000 gallons	-----	\$ 1.40 per 1000 gallons per quarter
NEXT	600,000 gallons	-----	\$ 1.20 per 1000 gallons per quarter
OVER	984,000 gallons	-----	\$1.00 per 1000 gallons per quarter."

is hereby amended to read as follows:

"All sewer rentals based upon water consumption shall be computed at the following rates based on metered water use:

FIRST	12,000 gallons	-----	\$28.00 minimum per quarter
NEXT	42,000 gallons	-----	\$ 2.15 per 1000 gallons per quarter
NEXT	90,000 gallons	-----	\$ 1.80 per 1000 gallons per quarter
NEXT	240,000 gallons	-----	\$1.60 per 1000 gallons per quarter
NEXT	600,000 gallons	-----	\$ 1.35 per 1000 gallons per quarter
OVER	984,000 gallons	-----	\$ 1.10 per 1000 gallons per quarter."

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1980.
