AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE MANDATORY RETIREMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT UPON THE ATTAINMENT OF THE AGE OF SIXTY-FIVE (65) YEARS.

WHEREAS, age is a bona fide occupational qualification reasonably necessary to the efficient operation of the police department; and

WHEREAS, physical ability generally declines with age; and

WHEREAS, members of the police force must exhibit a high condition of physical fitness to protect the public and to carry out its many duties inherent in the position of police officer; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of the expedient enforcement of our criminal laws and the efficient administration of our criminal justice system, which enforcement and administration necessarily requiring that the police force be and remain in a high state of physical conditioning to carry out the many and varied physical commitments of employment as a police officer; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is reasonably necessary for the proper regulation and administration of the pension plan and retirement funds; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance will serve to reasonably enhance the acturial soundness of the retirement fund.
