CORRECTIVE ORDINANCE 80-5

A CORRECTIVE ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP  
OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
CORRECTING THE MILLAGE RATE AS PREVIOUSLY  
LISTED IN ORDINANCE 79-7 UNDER SECTION 1  
SUB-SECTION (a) and (b).

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under the First Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, located in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, did enact Ordinance No. 79-7 on December 26, 1979, adopting a budget for the calendar year 1980; and

WHEREAS, under Section 1, Sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) the incorrect millage as well as the dollar amount was listed;

NOW THEREFORE, Section 1, Sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) are hereby corrected to read as follows:

- (a) For general Township purposes, the sum of 17.6 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of One and 76/100 Dollars (\$1.76) on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.
- (b) For debt purposes the sum of 1.4 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of (14¢) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

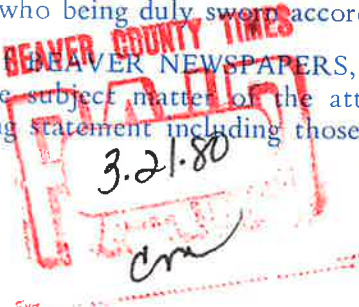
