ORDINANCE NO. 80-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FORMALLY ACCEPTING AS TOWNSHIP STREETS, THOSE PORTIONS OF MCKINLEY STREET AND LINCOLN AVENUE WHICH ARE OPEN AND WHICH HAVE BEEN FULLY MAINTAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS BUT NEVER FORMALLY ACCEPTED.

WHEREAS, drivers streets have been laid out within Hopewell Township and dedicated to public use for highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, there appears to be no record of formal acceptance of the dedication of said streets; and

WHEREAS, the Township has for a number of years fully maintained said streets and treated the same as -accepted public streets.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation under the First Class Township Code, situate in the County of Beaver and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained:

1. That pursuant to the authority contained in the First Class Township Code all of the streets hereinafter described are hereby accepted as Township streets:

(a). Lincoln Avenue - A portion of Lincoln Avenue described as follows: Beginning at a point said point being the intersection of the easterly right-of-way line of McKinley Street (a 40 foot right-of-way) with the northerly right-of-way line of Lincoln Avenue (a 40 foot right-of-way), thence from said point of intersection $S58^{\circ} - 54' - 55''E$ a distance of 20 feet to a point on the centerline of Lincoln Avenue the true place of beginning, thence along said centerline of Lincoln Avenue $S31^{\circ} - 05' - 55''W$, a distance of 225 feet.

All as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

(b). McKinley Street - A portion of McKinley Street described as follows: Beginning at a point said point being the intersection of the easterly right-of-way line of Division Street with the westerly right-of-way line McKinley Street (a 40 foot right-of-way) thence from said point of intersection N31°-05'-05"E a distance of 20 feet to a point on the centerline of McKinley Street the true place of beginning, thence along said centerline of McKinley Street-S58°-54'-55"E a distance of 240 feet.

All as shown Exhibit "B" attached hereto.

2. That the aforesaid streets are declared to be and shall hereafter be regarded as part of the highway system of the Township of Hopewell.
