ORDINANCE 82-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE 1982 CALENDAR YEAR AND APPROPRIATING SPECIFIC SUMS ESTIMATED TO BE REQUIRED FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSES OF THE TOWNSHIP GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under the First Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, located in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED:

SECTION 1, That for and during the 1982 calendar year a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all real property within the said Township of Hopewell subject to taxation for Township purposes, at the following rates:

- (a) For general Township purposes, the sum of 3.64 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of thirty-six.four cents(.364) on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.
- (b) For debt purposes the sum of .3 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of three (3¢) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

The total tax rate for all Township purposes being the sum of three. nine four mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of thirty-nine.four cents (.394¢) each on one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

SECTION 2. That the estimated expenses of Township government and the amounts appropriated therefore from the revenue estimated to be derived during the calendar year ending December 31, 1982, are fully set forth in the adopted budget of the Township, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Township Secretary, at the Hopewell Township Municipal Building, Clark Boulevard, in the said Township of Hopewell and the Pennsylvania Department of Community Affairs.
