ORDINANCE NO. 82-5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TAKING OVER AND ADOPTING WASHINGTON STREET AND SCOTTSWOOD DRIVE, IN THE SCOTTSWOOD APARTMENTS PLAN IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AS PUBLIC STREETS,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. The following streets in Scottswood Apartments, as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Beaver County, Pennsylvania, in Plan Book 16, page 172, are hereby taken over and adopted as public streets in the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania:

(a) Washington Street, having a fifty (50) foot right of way and a twenty-four (24) foot cartway at existing grades beginning at Longvue Avenue and terminating at McKinley Avenue, a distance of 1830 linear feet.


(b) Scottswood Drive, having a fifty (50) foot right of way and a twenty-four (24) foot cartway at existing grades beginning at Washington Street and terminating at a cul-de-sac, a distance of 881 linear feet.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 13 th day of July, 1982.

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
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
