ORDINANCE NO. 84- 2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 69-2, ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF TOWNSHIP MANAGER-SECRETARY IN SAID TOWNSHIP, PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF FILLING SAID OFFICE, TERM, COMPENSATION, AND POWERS AND DUTIES OF SAID OFFICE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the authority of the same as more specifically set out in 53 P.S. 55901, et al., as amended:

1. That Section 5. of said Ordinance 69-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. The Township Manager-Secretary shall receive compensation in the amount of Twenty-Six Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$26,700.00) per year.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into Ordinance this 24th day of April, 1984.

This Ordinance shall be effective retroactively as of February 1, 1984.
