ORDINANCE NO. 86- 1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING THE OFFICE OF TOWNSHIP MANAGER.

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Board of Commissioners have determined that the best interests of the Township require that the specific office of Township Manager be created to act as the chief administrative officer of said Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell had pursuant to Ordinance No. 69-2 established the office of Manager-Secretary specifically reciting that said office would be responsible for discharge of the duties of the Township Secretary; and

WHEREAS, the office of Township Secretary is primarily responsible for officially keeping the Township Minutes and for performing such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Board of Commissioners;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the authority of the same:

Section 1: The office of Township Manager is hereby created by the Township of Hopewell to serve as the chief administrative officer of the Township.

Section 2: The Township Manager shall be appointed by a majority vote of the Township Board of Commissioners and shall serve for a term of office as set forth by Township resolution at the time of appointment.

Section 3: The Township Manager shall be responsible for all duties and shall exercise such powers as may from time to time be delegated by the Township Board of Commissioners as a whole; no duty shall be given, nor power conferred, that would represent a non-delegable legislative and/or judicial duty or power.

Section 4: The Township Manager shall receive such compensation as may from time to time be set by appropriate resolution of the Township Board of Commissioners.

Section 5: The Township Manager, shall, if required by the Township Commissioners, give a bond to the Township, with a surety company or other company authorized by law to act as surety, to be approved by the Commissioners in such sum as it shall, by ordinance or resolution, direct, conditioned for the faithful performance of his/her duties.

Section 6: The enactment of this Ordinance shall operate as a repeal of Ordinance No. 69-2 and any amendments thereto.

Section 7: This ordinance is being enacted pursuant to the Act of 1931, June 24, P.L. 1206 Article XV, Section 1502, Clause IV; 1949, May 27, P.L. 1955, Section 31; 1953, July 2, P.L. 326, Section 1.
