ORDINANCE NO. 86-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 81-7  
SETTING FORTH CERTAIN MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS  
WITHIN THE FLOODPLAIN DISTRICTS OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

I. The title of Article V shall be rewritten to read:

ARTICLE V - PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES IN THE FLOODPLAIN

II. A Section 5.00 D. shall be added to read:

D. The commencement of, or any construction of, a new mobile home park or mobile home subdivision, or substantial improvement to an existing mobile home park or mobile home subdivision.

III. A Subsection numbered 7 shall be added to Article VII to read:

Except for a possible modification of the freeboard requirements involved, no variance shall be granted for any of the other requirements pertaining specifically to Development Which May Endanger Human Life (Section 4.02). No variance shall be granted for any activity prohibited in Article V.
