ORDINANCE NO. 86-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, COUNTY OF BEAVER AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, DESIGNATING LANTERN LANE, A TOWNSHIP STREET, AS A NON-PARKING ZONE EXCEPT AS TO ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell have determined that portions of Lantern Lane are utilized by certain unknown individuals to conduct loud and unruly gatherings which pose a nuisance to residents of the community; and

WHEREAS, the parking of non-resident vehicles upon such streets has been determined to be detrimental to the residents thereof; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is as follows:

- A. To reduce hazardous conditions resulting from the use of streets within areas zoned for residential uses for the parking of vehicles by persons using such areas for immoral, criminal, and/or defiant activities; and
- B. To protect the residential area from excessive noise, traffic and refuse caused by the entry of non-resident vehicles onto Lantern Lane; and
- C. To protect the residents of Lantern Lane from unreasonable burdens in gaining access to their residences; and
- D. To preserve the residential character of Lantern Lane; and
- E. To promote efficiency in the maintenance of this street in a clean and safe condition; and
- F. To preserve the value of the property adjoining Lantern Lane; and
- G. To preserve the safety of children and other pedestrians and traffic safety, and the peace, good order, comfort, convenience and welfare of the inhabitants of the Township of Hopewell;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township of Hopewell, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

DEFINITIONS

1. Resident - The term "resident" when used herein shall mean an individual permanently residing in a dwelling which immediately abuts a residential street as designated herein.

REGULATIONS

2. Notwithstanding any provision of this Ordinance to the contrary, the parking of any vehicle on Lantern Lane remains subject to all parking regulations established pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Ordinances of the Township of Hopewell.

3. That Lantern Lane is hereby designated a non-parking area except as hereinafter may be set forth.

4. Except as hereinafter provided in Paragraph 5, no person shall park or leave standing any vehicle at any time upon Lantern Lane.

5. A resident of a dwelling located upon Lantern Lane as designated in Paragraph 1 hereof may park a vehicle at all times upon the portion of Lantern Lane immediately abutting the lot line of the lot upon which such resident resides.

6. The Hopewell Police Department shall generally be chargeable with the enforcement of this ordinance and shall utilize discretion in the enforcement thereof so as not to place a burden upon the residents abutting said Lantern Lane when said residents have guests, are engaging in social gatherings, or the like.

7. Lantern Lane shall be posted with parking signs indicating "resident parking only".

8. The violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall subject the violator thereof to a fine not exceeding Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00).

9. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the date of its adoption.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into an Ordinance this 9 day of Sept., 1986.
