Ordinance 88-2 Mgmt. Community Park

ORDINANCE NO. 88-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 80-6 WHICH ORDINANCE PROVIDES FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND REGULATION OF THE HOPEWELL COMMUNITY PARK.

WHEREAS, The Township of Hopewell enacted Ordinance No. 80-6 on June 10, 1980, to provide for the effective management, to provide regulations for the conduct of persons in the park, and to prescribe penalties for the violation of those regulations; and

WHEREAS, the citizenry of the Township of Hopewell has from time to time over the past several years voiced complaints with respect to dog litter (fece) being deposited throughout the park by persons bringing their dogs onto the park premises; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned complaints have markedly increased and the Township has independently determined that said complaints are both real and legitimate and that the depositing of dog litter (fece) in the park presents a danger to the health, safety, and welfare of persons attempting to utilize the park grounds;

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation under the First Class Township Code situate in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED that Ordinance No. 80-6 is amended to include the following new sub-sections:

SECTION 2.

(v) No person shall bring any dog nor permit any dog to be in the park at any time.

(w) Subsection (m) shall remain a part of the within Ordinance but shall have no applicability to dogs.

SECTION 4.

The duly appointed Township Dog Officer shall have the responsibility to enforce the provisions of the within Ordinance that refers to dogs; the Hopewell Township Police Department shall assist the efforts of the Park Director, Park Attendant, or Dog Officer in enforcing any of the provisions fo this Ordinance as may from time to time be necessary
