ORDINANCE NO. 89- 2 TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF ALL TYPES OF MECHANICAL ELECTRONICAL, AND ELECTRONIC SPEED TIMING DEVICES AND AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved, by the Board of Commissioners of the TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, a municipal corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, being situate in the County of Beaver of said Commonwealth, as follows:

SECTION 1: SHORT TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as "Speed Timing Devices" Ordinance of the Township of Hopewell.

SECTION 2: ENACTMENT

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority conferred by the "Vehicle Code", Act of 1976, June 17, P.L. 162, No. 81 sl, effective July 1, 1977 (75 Pa. C.S.A. s101 et. seq.) as amended, and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation Rules and Regulations (67 Pa. Code Chapter 105 et. seq.) as amended.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.

SECTION 4: DEFINITIONS

The following words when used in this Ordinance shall have the meaning ascribed to them in this Section, except in those instances where the context clearly indicates a different meaning;

SPEED TIMING DEVICE- every type of mechanical, electrical, electrical-mechanical, and electronic speed timing device as are now, or may be from time to time, authorized and/or approved for use in the "Vehicle Code", 75 Pa. C.S.A. s101 et. seq., as amended and (A) by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, in their Rules and Regulations, 67, pa. Code Chapter 105 et. seq., as amended.

SECTION 5:

FINDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP

The Board of Commissioners have determined and hereby determine that a reasonable exercise of their police power requires that the Police Department be authorized to (a) enforce speed restrictions as are now, or may be from time to time, established by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Township of Hopewell on any roads within the Township of Hopewell; (b) use any speed timing device to enforce said speed restrictions.

SECTION 6: POLICE DEPARTMENT AUTHORITY ESTABLISHED

The Police Department of the Township of Hopewell is hereby authorized to do the following:

- (A) Enforce any and all speed restrictions as are now, or may be from time to time, established by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and/ or the Township of Hopewell on any and all roads within the Township of Hopewell.
- (B) Use any speed timing device in the enforcement of any speed restrictions contained in subsection (A).

SECTION 7: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause or section of this Ordinance is for any reason soon found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentences, clause or section not been included herein.

SECTION 8: REPEALS

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the Ordinance						
are hereby repealed in so far as they may be inconsistent herewith.
