ORDINANCE 95-5

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL,
BEAVER COUNTY, APPROPRIATING MONIES FROM
MUNICIPAL TAXES AND REVENUES TO DEFRAY
EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE TOWNSHIP FOR
FOR THE THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31,
1996.**

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby
ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of
Hopewell, County of Beaver, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and
enacted according to the power and authority granted under the First
Class Township code, Act of December 14, 1967, P.L. 819, effective
January 1, 1969;**

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money, or as much
thereof as may be authorized by law, as may be needed or deemed
necessary to defray all expenses and liabilities of the Township, be and
the same are hereby appropriated for the purposes and objects of said
Township hereinafter specified for fiscal year commencing on the first
day of January 1996 and ending on the thirty-first day of December 1996
