ORDINANCE 97-10

**A ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL,
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING TAX RATES
FOR THE 1998 CALENDAR YEAR AND APPROPRIATING
SPECIFIC SUMS ESTIMATED TO BE REQUIRED FOR
SPECIFIC PURPOSES OF THE TOWNSHIP GOVERNMENT.**

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Commissioners
of the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County, a Municipal Corporation
under the First Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,

SECTION 1. That for and during the 1998 calendar year, a tax be and the
same is hereby levied on all property within said Township of Hopewell, subject
to taxation for Township purposes.

The total tax rate for all Township purposes being the sum of nine mills
on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of ninety cents (.90) on each
hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

SECTION 2. That collection period shall be two per cent (2%) discount from
March first through April thirtieth, face from May first through June thirtieth,
ten percent (10%) penalty assessed after June thirtieth.

SECTION 3. That the estimated expenses of Township government and the
amounts appropriated therefore from the revenue estimated to be derived during
the calendar year ending December thirty-first, 1998 are fully set forth in the
adopted budget of the Township, a copy of which is on file in the office of the
Township Secretary, at the Township Municipal Building, 1700 Clark Boulevard,
Aliquippa, Pennsylvania and the Pennsylvania Department of Community
Affairs.
