ORDINANCE NO. 2000-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, A FIRST CLASS TOWNSHIP UNDER THE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, SITUATE IN BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION TO BE PAID THE TOWNSHIP COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Commissioners are being paid an annual salary of Two Thousand Four Hundred (\$2,400.00) Dollars as set forth in the year 1990 by Ordinance No. 90-4; and

WHEREAS, the current population of Hopewell Township is between Ten Thousand (10,000) and Fifteen Thousand (15,000) people;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the First Class Township Code, 53 P.S. section 55703, and in accordance with the Township population, the Township Commissioners may currently be paid an annual salary of Three Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty (\$3,250.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Township Commissioners are desirous of setting their compensation at the lawful rate in accordance with the First Class Township Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners for the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under the First Class Township Code and the legal authority contained therein, said Township being situate in Beaver County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

1. Pursuant to the First Class Township Code, 53 P.S. section 55703, and in accordance with the population of the Township of Hopewell, the salary of the Township Commissioners is hereby increased from Two Thousand Four Hundred (\$2,400.00) Dollars annually to Three Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty (\$3,250.00) Dollars annually effective immediately.
2. All Ordinances, in particular Ordinance No. 90-4, or parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that inconsistency.
