

RESOLUTION NO. 86-106

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL,  
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING A MONETARY  
COMMITMENT OF \$150,000.00 (ONE HUNDRED, FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS)  
TO THE COUNTY OF BEAVER WITH RESPECT TO THE DEVELOPMENT  
OF AN INDUSTRIAL PARK WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL

WHEREAS, the County of Beaver is in the process of developing an Industrial Park within the territorial boundaries of the Township of Hopewell that is anticipated to be of economic benefit to the residents of the Township of Hopewell and the County of Beaver; and

WHEREAS, the County of Beaver has requested that the Township of Hopewell participate in the development of said Industrial Park by committing the sum of \$150,000.00 to aid in defraying the costs necessary to complete this project; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell has determined that making such a commitment would be in the best interests of the community; and that said commitment should be directed toward, where possible, the construction of sanitary sewer systems as part of the infrastructure of the development.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves:

1. The Township of Hopewell hereby authorizes the monetary commitment of the sum of \$150,000.00 (One Hundred, Fifty Thousand Dollars) to the County of Beaver in connection with the development of the Hopewell Industrial Park.
