

RESOLUTION NO. 86-111

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, SUPPORTING THE PROM-GRADUATION COMMUNITY ACTION PROGRAM
COMMENCING APRIL 11, 1986 AND ENDING APRIL 18, 1986

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell is cognizant of the fact that the
partaking of alcoholic beverages by teenagers during the graduation period is
both a troublesome and often tragic concern; and

WHEREAS, several local businesses and/or merchants situated in the
Township of Hopewell have organized to voice their concern about this problem
by initiating a Prom-Graduation Community Action Program; and

WHEREAS, it is the objective of this program to educate the community
with respect to the dangers and sometimes fatal consequences of teenage drinking;
and to further promote the safety and welfare of our school children during
the prom and graduation festivities; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell is desirous of expressing its
whole-hearted support for the Prom-Graduation Community Action Program.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the
Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township
Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves:

1. That the Township of Hopewell hereby approves and offers its
support to the Prom-Graduation Community Action Program and hereby declares
the period from April 11, 1986 to April 18, 1986 as Prom-Graduation Community
Action Week.
