

RESOLUTION NO. 87-100

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPOINTING JAMES M. EICHENLAUB TO THE OFFICE OF TOWNSHIP MANAGER-SECRETARY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 86-8.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell are desirous of appointing a professional person to the office of Township Manager-Secretary of the Township of Hopewell; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that James M. Eichenlaub possesses the requisite professional qualifications, both educationally and by virtue of prior work experience, to assume the position of Township Manager-Secretary of the Township of Hopewell; and

WHEREAS, the said James M. Eichenlaub has worked with the Township Commissioners in preparing the Township budget for the fiscal year 1987; and

WHEREAS, based upon the Township Commissioners' experience in working on the 1987 budget with James M. Eichenlaub, said Commissioners have had the opportunity to observe Mr. Eichenlaub's professionalism in a personal and first hand setting.


NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class Township Code, situate in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved:

1. That James M. Eichenlaub is hereby appointed Township Manager Secretary of the Township of Hopewell pursuant to Ordinances No. 69-2, 84-2 and 86-8, as amended.



That the effective date of this Resolution shall be January 1, 1987, in accordance with the representations made by the Township Board of Commissioners at a public meeting held on December 31, 1986, at which meeting it was announced that it was important to the efficient operation of the Township that Mr. Eichenlaub preliminarily assume the duties of Township Manager-Secretary as of that date.
