RESOLUTION NO. 87-109

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, INCREASING THE MONTHLY BENEFIT OF RETIRED PENSIONERS \$100.00 (ONE-HUNDRED DOLLARS) PER MONTH WITH RESPECT TO PARTICIPANTS IN THE PENSION PLAN ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION NO. 57-106, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell has determined, based upon the recommendation of the Township Actuary, that retired pensioners in the pension plan established by Resolution 57-106 and as amended by subsequent resolutions, should receive an increase in the monthly benefit in the amount of \$100.00 (One-hundred Dollars).

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation, under the First Class

Township Code, situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby resolves:

- 1. That retired pensioners in the pension plan established by Resolution 57-106, as amended, shall receive an increase in the monthly benefit in the amount of \$100.00 (One-hundred Dollars).
- 2. This Resolution shall be effective retroactively as of January 1, 1987.
