

RESOLUTION NO. 87-125

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROPRIATING MONIES FROM THE CAPITOL PROJECTS AND SEWER CONSTRUCTION FUNDS IN ORDER TO CONFORM TO BUDGETARY EXPENDITURES FOR THE YEAR 1987 PURSUANT TO 53 P.S. SECTION 56701.

WHEREAS, the adoption of budgetary appropriations for the year 1987 inadvertently omitted monies to be expended from the Capitol Projects and Sewer Construction funds; and

WHEREAS, monies from the above funds were from time to time expended for lawful purposes as budgeted; and

WHEREAS, the Township filed these budgetary appropriations with the Pennsylvania Department of Community Affairs and the Clerk of Courts for the County of Beaver; and

WHEREAS, the Township is desirous of conforming ordinance number 86-9 to actual anticipated expenditures as submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Community Affairs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, under the First Class Code, and it hereby resolves:

1. The appropriation for the Capitol Projects fund for the year 1987 is, and has been \$ 700,000.
2. The appropriation for the Sewer Construction fund for the year 1987 is, and has been \$230,000.
