A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL  
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, MAKING APPLICATION  
TO INSTALL FLASHING WARNING DEVICES FOR A SCHOOL  
ZONE ADJACENT TO MARGARET ROSS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL,  
LOCATED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County,  
desires to erect, operate and maintain flashing warning  
devices on Maratta Road for Margaret Ross Elementary  
School and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle Code requires the approval of  
the Secretary of Transportation, before any device may be  
legally erected or reconstructed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that flashing warning  
devices be erected at the above mentioned location,  
subject to the approval of the Secretary of  
Transportation, and that his approval is hereby requested,  
and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, in the event a permit  
for these devices is approved after proper investigation,  
the Township will be bound by the following provisions:

The devices shall be installed and maintained in  
accordance with the Vehicle Code and the Regulations for  
traffic signs, signals and marking of the Department of  
Transportation and

Should future highway or traffic conditions, or legal  
requirements, necessitate alteration of the construction  
or operation, or hours of operation, or removal of the  
flashing warning devices at the above mentioned location,  
they shall be altered or removed when and as directed by  
the Secretary of Transportation.
