

RESOLUTION NO. 92-112

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL IN CONJUNCTION WITH CERTAIN NEIGHBORING MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE FEASIBILITY OF COOPERATIVE POLICE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell is desirous of having a detailed study of regional "lock-up" services conducted in Hopewell Township, in conjunction with neighboring municipalities, and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Consulting Services Division of the Department of Community Affairs, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is willing, under certain conditions, to conduct a study to determine the feasibility of developing cooperative police services, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell appoints James Eichenlaub its representative of the Police Study Committee, which will serve as liaison to D C A project staff and which will perform other functions determined by the Committee to be necessary for the successful completion of the study, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell agrees to permit access to municipal records and personnel to the degree determined to be necessary by D C A study personnel, and

THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell that the Municipal Consulting Services Division of the Department of Community Affairs, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania be authorized to conduct a study of law enforcement services in the Township of Hopewell in conjunction with neighboring municipalities for the purpose of determining the feasibility of cooperative police services.
