

RESOLUTION NO. 93-117

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AUTHORIZING THE CLOSING OF BOCKTOWN ROAD DUE TO THE FACT THAT SAID ROADWAY HAS BEEN RENDERED UNFIT FOR TRAVEL AND IMMEDIATE REPAIR IS NOT POSSIBLE.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell has been made aware that Bocktown Road is being utilized for the dumping of garbage and debris, including metal appliances and other materials; and

WHEREAS, said Bocktown Road has been subject to erosion and slides which have rendered said roadway unfit and unsafe for vehicular travel; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell intends on conducting an appropriate evaluation pursuant to engineering studies for the purpose of devising a means to remedy the aforesaid conditions existing on Bocktown road; and

WHEREAS, in that it is impractical and/or impossible to immediately remedy the defective condition of Bocktown Road, the Township Board of Commissioners have concluded that said roadway should be closed to further the safety and welfare of the traveling public;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved and the same is hereby resolved that

1. Bocktown road, a public roadway, lying within the Township of Hopewell is hereby closed pursuant to 53 P.S. Section 57014 of the First Class Township Code.
