## RESOLUTION 93-128

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICERS TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS FOR THE TRANSFER IN OWNERSHIP OF PROPERTY FROM THE BEAVER COUNTY CORPORATION FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TO THE TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, the Beaver County Corporation for Economic Development developed a 97 acre property known as the Hopewell Business and Industrial Park to allow Beaver County to participate in business growth occurring in the vicinity of the Pittsburgh International Airport, and

WHEREAS, two residual parcels which comprise approximately 37 unusable acres are not projected for development, and

WHEREAS, these parcels serve as buffers between the Industrial Park and adjacent residential subdivisions, and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to ensure this buffer continues to exist, and

WHEREAS, the Beaver County Corporation for Economic Development has agreed to continue maintenance of the storm water management system located within the Industrial Park,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved, that the Township agrees to purchase the 37 acres described herein and further described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto for one dollar (\$1), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the President and Secretary of the Board of Township Commissioners are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Township, documents necessary to facilitate the Transfer of Property.
