A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL,  
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, INDICATING  
OUR SUPPORT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COST  
ANALYSIS FOR A PROJECT TO DEVELOP AND  
OPERATE HOLDING CELLS

WHEREAS, we are faced with the challenge of providing increased services for our residents while trying to maintain the line on taxes;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of all to provide for the most fair and efficient way to provide necessary services and to reduce municipal liability;

WHEREAS, a regional approach to providing holding cells is a desirable service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a Municipal Corporation situated in Beaver County, Pennsylvania resolve to undertake the following:

1. Appoint a representative to participate in meetings with other members of our region with other municipalities and representatives from state agencies interested in promoting a cooperative effort.
2. The municipality will provide the appropriate data concerning its jurisdiction to aid in this effort.
3. This representative will report the status of the project to this legislative body on a regular basis.
