

RESOLUTION 95-129

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING AN EDUCATIONAL SERVICE AGENCY TO COMPLY WITH ACT 108 OF 1979 (H.B. 1108, P.N. 2578) AMENDING RESOLUTION NUMBER 80-104, WHICH CREATED AN EDUCATIONAL SERVICE AGENCY TO COMPLY WITH ACT 108 OF 1979 (H.B. 1108, P.N. 2578), BY NAMING THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL AS THE EMPLOYEE SUPERVISOR OF THE EDUCATIONAL SERVICE AGENCY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF SUPERVISING, TRAINING AND MAINTAINING COMPLETE CONTROL OVER ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE AGENCY. SAID POSITION TO BE COMPENSATED AT AN ANNUAL SALARY OF ONE (1.00) DOLLAR FROM THE ACCOUNTS OF SAID AGENCY.

WHEREAS, recent Pennsylvania court decisions have made it necessary for Hopewell Township to Amend Resolution 80-104 to avoid incurring otherwise improper and excessive unemployment compensation costs for certain employees of the Educational Service Agency of the Township of Hopewell, (hereinafter "ESATH"), including but not limited to School Crossing Guards, during certain holiday and summer vacation periods as provided by the appropriate school calendar; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with recent court decisions to avoid incurring otherwise improper and excessive unemployment compensation costs, the Township of Hopewell must create and fill the position of Employee Supervisor in the ESATH whose primary responsibilities shall be to supervise, train and control the employees of the ESATH which, at this time, only

includes the School Crossing Guards; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the Township of Hopewell is the individual best suited to serve in and fill this position; and

WHEREAS, The ESATH pays its employees out of its own accounts and the Employee Supervisor shall also be paid from these accounts at an annual salary of one (\$1.00) dollar with no other benefits of any kind to be provided from the ESATH;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell, a municipal corporation under the First Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, located in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. That there is hereby created the Position of Employee Supervisor within the Educational Service Agency of the Township of Hopewell to be filled by the Chief of Police of the Township of Hopewell, and

2. That the primary responsibilities of the Employee Supervisor are to supervise, train and control the employees of the Educational Service Agency of the Township of Hopewell, namely, the School Crossing Guards, and

3. That the Supervisor shall be compensated at an annual salary of one (\$1.00) dollar to be paid from the accounts of the Educational Service Agency of the Township of Hopewell with no other benefits.
