

RESOLUTION NO. 97-135

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, A
FIRST CLASS TOWNSHIP UNDER THE LAWS OF THE
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING
COSTS TO BE IMPOSED PURSUANT TO TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. 97-9 PROHIBITING FALSE ALARMS

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell, Beaver County,
Pennsylvania, has passed a False Alarm Ordinance at No. 97-9A
the purpose of which is stated therein; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforementioned Ordinance, the
Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township are empowered to
establish a cost schedule to be imposed upon premises owners from
wherein a false alarm emanates; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby establish the
following cost schedule according to the number of false alarms set
during one calendar year:

First:	Warning
Second through Fifth:	Fifty (\$50) Dollars each
Sixth through Tenth:	One Hundred (\$100) Dollars each
Eleven or More:	Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars each
