## RESOLUTION NO. 99-104

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF A "NO LEFT HAND TURN" SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF MAPLE AVENUE AND MILL STREET AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Hopewell has determined that it is necessary to authorize the placement of a "NO LEFT HAND TURN" sign at the intersection of Maple Avenue and Mill Street to better control safe access onto Mill Street and to provide for the overall safety of vehicular movement throughout the Maple Avenue Mill Street corridor, and;

WHEREAS, the Township did consult the Pennsylvania Department of Transpiration and receive their recommendation in conjunction with the safety problems encountered by motorists using Maple Avenue for ingress / egress to Mill Street and;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. Left hand turns are prohibited from Maple Avenue (West) on to Mill Street.

Section 2. Any person convicted in violation of this order shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25.00 plus the costs of prosecution.
