A RESOLUTION OF THE VACANCY BOARD OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, A FIRST CLASS
TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
APPOINTING Ted Pajak Jr. TO FILL THE VACANCY
CREATED ON THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
BY THE RESIGNATION OF GEORGE KOZLINA

WHEREAS George Kozlina resigned from the Board of
Commissioners of Hopewell Township on March 9th, 1999;

WHEREAS under the First Class Township Code, 53 P.S.
§55530, the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township are
authorized to fill a vacancy in the Office of Township Commissioner
by appointing a registered voter of the Township within thirty (30)
days after the vacancy occurs;


WHEREAS under the First Class Township Code, 53 P.S.
§55530, if the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township fail to
fill a vacancy in the Office of Township Commissioner by appointing
a registered voter of the Township, the Vacancy Board of Hopewell
Township is authorized to convene and fill the vacancy by
appointing a registered voter of the Township;

WHEREAS the Vacancy Board of Hopewell Township hereby
appoints Ted Pajak, Jr., a registered voter of Hopewell
Township, to fill the vacancy in the Office of Township
Commissioner created by the resignation of George Kozlina;

WHEREAS pursuant to the First Class Township Code, 53
P.S. §55520, Ted Pajak, Jr. shall hold the Office of Township
Commissioner until the first Monday in January after the first

municipal election occurring more than sixty (60) days after the vacancy occurs.

And I do further swear (or affirm) that I do not advocate, nor am I knowingly a member of any organization that advocates the overthrow of the government of the United States of this Commonwealth, by force or violence or other unconstitutional means, or seeking by force or violence to deny other persons their rights under the Constitution of the United States or of the Commonwealth.

And I do further swear (or affirm) that I will not so advocate, nor will I knowingly become a member of such organization during the period that I am an employee of the Township of
Hopewell

NOTE: The foregoing oath shall be administered by any person duly authorized by law to administer oaths. Any person failing or refusing to execute this oath shall be discharged immediately by the proper appointing authority. Notice is hereby given that this oath is subject to the penalties of perjury, a felony: To wit, a fine not exceeding three thousand dollars (\$3,000), or imprisonment by separate or solitary confinement at labor not exceeding seven (7) years, or both, and disqualification forever from being a witness in any matter in controversy.
