**Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township requesting that the Board of County Commissioners of Beaver County authorize and permit local municipalities to access undesignated 911 funds, pursuant to House Bill 911, for the funding of various applicable local programs.**

**Whereas,** Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township is a local municipality located within Beaver County, Pennsylvania: and

**Whereas,** Beaver County is served by 911 Police and Fire Protection Programs; and

**Whereas,** Act 78 of 1990 authorized the imposition of a surcharge on certain telephone bills on a monthly basis for the construction and the maintenance of the 911 system; and

**Whereas,** House Bill 911 which was passed in February of 1998 authorized the use of 911 surcharge funds to reimburse municipalities for certain municipal expenditures; and

**Whereas,** House Bill 911 designates as applicable projects the reimbursement of expenditures for mobile communications equipment, training and the erection of street signs pursuant to the development of a master street guide; and

**Whereas,** Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township desires to incur and be reimbursed for certain municipal expenditures pursuant to House Bill 911; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP DOES HEREBY REQUEST THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BEAVER COUNTY REVIEW AND APPROVE A POLICY FOR THE BUDGETING AND USE OF UNDESIGNATED FUNDS UNDER THE 911FUND SO THAT MUNICIPALITIES IN BEAVER COUNTY CAN BE REIMBURSED FOR APPLICABLE MUNICIPAL EXPENDITURES.**
