THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP borrow the sum of FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS from the WOODLAWN TRUST COMPANY, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, in anticipation of the receipt of taxes which will be levied for the year 1956, and other current revenues which will be collectible during the year 1956, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a Certificate of Indebtedness payable ninety (90) days from the date of same be executed and delivered to the WOODLAWN TRUST COMPANY, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS, at the time of negotiation of said loan.
