

RESOLUTION NO. 56-105

WHEREAS, there are not sufficient moneys in the General Fund with which to pay the necessary costs of government which are due in April, 1956, and

WHEREAS, revenues for 1956 will not be available in time and amount to meet the current obligations which will be presented during such period.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP borrow the sum of FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS from the WOODLAWN TRUST COMPANY, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, in anticipation of the receipt of taxes which will be levied for the year 1956, and other current revenues which will be collectible during the year 1956, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a Certificate of Indebtedness payable *sixty* days from the date of the same be executed and delivered to the WOODLAWN TRUST COMPANY, Aliquippa, Pennsylvania, in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS, at the time of negotiation of said loan.
