

# Resolution 56-109

PROVIDING THAT IF THE HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY DOES NOT SELL ITS BONDS AND DOES NOT PAY TO GANNETT FLEMING CORDDRY & CARPENTER, INC. THE AMOUNT DUE FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES TO BE RENDERED TO THE AUTHORITY UNDER THE AGREEMENT OF JULY 10, 1956, THE TOWNSHIP WILL ASSUME AND PAY THE AMOUNTS STIPULATED IN THE HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH SAID ENGINEERING FIRM TO THAT EFFECT.

WHEREAS, the Hopewell Township Municipal Authority has entered into an Agreement dated July 10, 1956 with Gannett Fleming Corddry & Carpenter, Inc., providing for certain terms and conditions for the making of preliminary studies, review of preliminary existing reports, the preparation of plans, specifications, and supervision of construction, as well as the furnishing of engineering services in connection with financing; and

WHEREAS, the said Authority does not presently have any assets and will not have any until it receives funds from the sale of its bonds;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Hopewell Township, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, that if the Hopewell Township Municipal Authority does not pay to Gannett Fleming Corddry and Carpenter, Inc., such amounts as shall become due to said firm under the aforesaid Agreement dated July 10, 1956, within a period of ninety (90) days after submission of the plans, specifications, contract documents and detailed estimates by the Engineers to the Authority, then the Township will assume and pay the amounts and at such times as are provided for in the Agreement hereinafter referred to.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township of Hopewell shall enter into an Agreement with Gannett Fleming Corddry & Carpenter, Inc. of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, in the form submitted to the Board of Township Commissioners and dated July 10, 1956, providing for payment of services as therein set forth, and the officers of the said Hopewell Township are hereby authorized to execute said Agreement on behalf of said Hopewell Township and to cause the corporate seal to be affixed.
