

RESOLUTION NO. 56-110

WHEREAS: The "flash flood" waters of May 11, 12, and 13th, caused damage to public facilities in the Township of Hopewell, county of Beaver, State of Pennsylvania, and

WHEREAS: The said Township of Hopewell is in need of aid in financing the emergency repair to replace in service said damaged facilities:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Officials of Township of Hopewell, in regular session on this, the second day of July, 1956, do hereby make application to the Federal Civil Defense Administration for an allocation of funds to be expended for repairing and restoring to service the aforesaid facilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following official, Paul Doughty, President, Board of Commissioners, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute the application form as required by the Federal Civil Defense Administration.
